

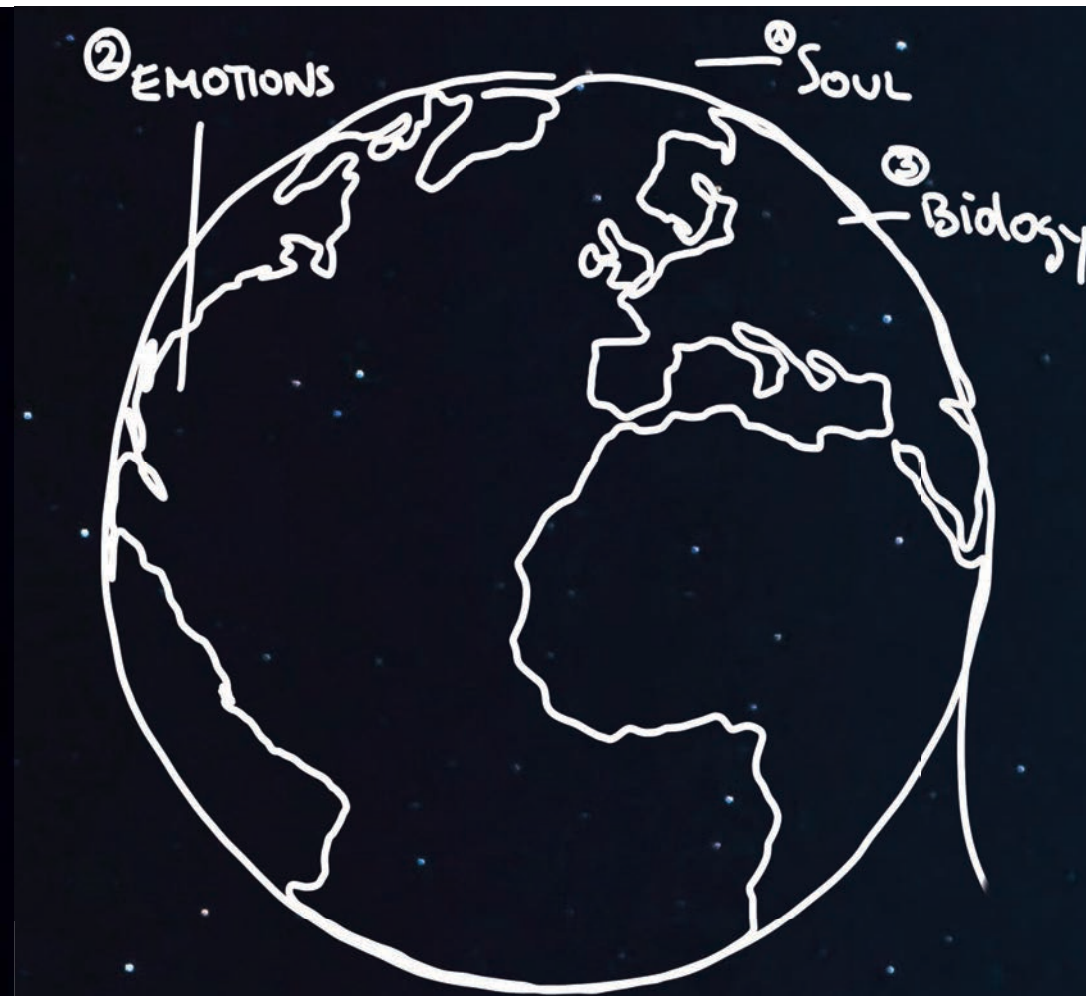
The Person in the three layers
